| Carpet | 10 inch $\times 10$ inch | With the least amount of residue, wear and damage possible. |
| Ceramic, Porcelain \& Stone Tiles | 6 inch $\times 6$ inch | A full tile, if smaller than 6 " $\times 6$ ", with the least amount of residue, wear and damage possible. Please note the color variation between tiles. |
| Laminate \& Wood | 8 inch $\times 10$ inch length | Width should be that of a full plank including the tongue and groove, from the cleanest and least damaged section possible. |
| Pads \& Underlayment | 6 inch $\times 6$ inch | From the cleanest and least damaged section possible. |
| Siding | 1 foot | Height should include from top of the nail hem to bottom edge. If possible, include a weep hole and the manufacturer's number that is embossed or printed on the nail hem or back of the material. |
| Vinyl | 4 inch $\times 4$ inch | From the cleanest and least damaged section possible. Include a portion of the pattern, if available. |
| Vinyl Sheet (Asbestos) | 2 inch $\times 2$ inch | Floors with multiple colors require three sample of each color. |
| Vinyl Tile (Asbestos) | 3 tiles from random areas of flooring | Floors with multiple colors require three sample of each color. |
